Angel Flight's pilots are flying free missions of mercy to transport medicine, food, clothes, general supplies, refugees and medical personnel.

***** Please deliver your donated items to Signature Flight Support at the Huntsville International Airport (2000 Houston Goodson Way, 256.772.9341) or call Angel Flight's Alabama Wing at 205.907.2645 to arrange for them to be picked up. *****

All items donated to Angel Flight's Alabama Wing, based in Huntsville, will be flown on private aircraft within 24-36 hours of being received. They will be flown to a distribution facility in Fairhope, Alabama where another set of pilots, including army rescue helicopters will pick up the items and deliver them to Hurricane ravaged areas of Mississippi and Louisiana.

Angel Flight® Southeast, a region of Angel Flight America, is registered through the federal government's Homeland Security Emergency Air Transportation System (HSEATS) to fly relief flights during national emergencies. Angel Flight Southeast is a 22-year-old 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that is composed of hundreds of experienced volunteer private pilots that own small, general aviation aircraft.

Diapers of various sizes (It's better to be bigger than too small ...)

New underwear of all sizes for children and adults

Ready to serve baby formula

Toiletries of all kinds -- shampoo, soap, disinfecting soap,

Hand sanitizer

Feminine products

Toothpaste

Toothbrushes

sunscreen

clean cloth towels, paper towels

medical supplies (contact your local hospital and drug store)

chainsaws

coolers

nails

hammers

clean-up supplies: brooms, shovels,

tarps

box fans -- there are even some now that run on batteries

cots to sleep on

Water

Gatorade-type drinks

Energy bars -- the kind that don't melt and get all mushy

Boxed food that doesn't have to be refrigerated
